Heifers must be born between 9/01/06 and 12/31/07 and will be divided into separate divisions before competing for overall top female. Steers will be divided into weight categories before competing for top market steer.

Added prize money in excess of \$2,000 is available. A showmanship contest will also be held and include a junior, intermediate, and senior division with an overall top showman award presented.
