

2009 Elkhorn Spring Classic Steer and Heifer Show Rules

General

1. Any exhibitor who violates any of the following will forfeit all premiums.
2. Exhibitors must be under 21 years of age as of the first day of the show year.
3. Animals must be in place by 9am of show day. Animals will be accepted starting Sunday prior to show.
4. The Baker County Fairboard accepts no liability for personal injury or losses.
5. Entry Fee for both heifers and steers is \$30 per head if preregistered by May 10, 2009. A \$35 fee will be per head if registering on show day.
6. Twenty five dollars of entry fee monies will be in the jackpot. Jackpot and added monies will be split on a percentage basis as determined by show management.
7. Generators are encouraged.
8. Bedding will be provided, but must be cleaned-out prior to departure.
9. **Premiums will be withheld if stalls are not cleaned.**
10. Show management reserves the right to alter and break classes to improve the show.
11. Exhibitor must do all fitting of livestock.

12. Any cattle coming from out of state must have health papers. Health papers need to be presented to show staff when checking in.

Heifers

1. Heifers must be born between 9/1/07 and 12/31/08
2. Heifers must be owned and shown by exhibitor.

Steers

1. Steers must be weighed in by 9:00 am of show day. Steers will be weighed from 7 – 9 a.m. on show day.
2. Steers must be owned and shown by the same exhibitor.
3. Classes will be broken by weight and determined after all steers are weighed.

Showmanship

1. Showmanship will consist of Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Divisions.
2. No entry required.
3. A pee-wee and adult showmanship will also be offered pending number of willing contestants.
