

## RULES AND REGULATIONS—CRAFT DIVISION

Exhibitors may enter two exhibits in a class, but are limited to one premium money per class.

1. All entries must be clean with no loose parts.
2. An exhibit may only be entered in the Baker County fair once.
3. School projects are acceptable in youth classes providing they are of the exhibitor's own design and work.
4. Any individual wishing to enter something for "EXHIBIT ONLY" is welcome to do so as long as there is room.
5. All model and Lego exhibits must to be covered with clear plastic wrap. Exhibits not covered will be re-fused entry.
6. All items need to be mounted or portable.
7. Classes with maximum and or minimum numbers or space requirements will be followed. Any entry that does not follow these rules will not be judged.
8. Collections with small items must be covered with clear plastic wrap or in a portable display case.
9. At the discretion of the superintendent a new category may be created if enough entries are submitted.
