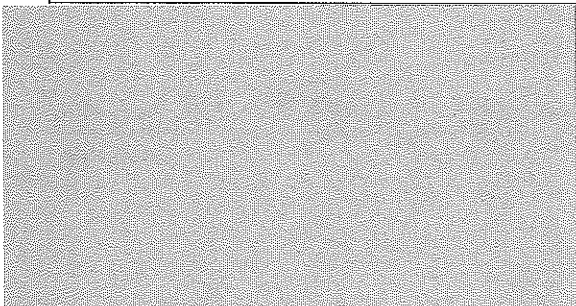


Request for Ballot Title Preparation or Publication of Notice

No later than the 80th day before an election, a governing body that has referred a measure must prepare and file with the local elections official the text of the referral for ballot title preparation or the ballot title for publication of notice of receipt of ballot title. This form may be used to file the text of the referral and request the elections official begin the ballot title drafting process or file a ballot title and request the elections official publish notice of receipt of ballot title.

Caption 10 words which reasonably identifies the subject of the measure. Four Year Local Option Tax for Vector Control General Operations
Question 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure. Shall Baker County levy \$140,000 annually for four years beginning fiscal year 2020-2021 for vector control services? This measure renews current local option Taxes.
Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect. This is a special levy outside the County's Tax base for general operations within the vector control district, which will include expenses for contractors and pesticides, as well as other operating expenses, to eradicate public health vectors within the district. The taxes needed for the four years total \$560,000, which will be levied in equal amounts of \$140,000 in each of the four years beginning 2020-2021 and ending fiscal year 2023-2024. It is estimated that the proposed tax will result in a rate of \$0.1537 per \$1,000 assessed valuation based on the 2019-2020 estimate. The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the County Assessor at the time of the estimate. The tax levy is subject to the limits of section 11(b) article 11 of the Oregon Constitution. All revenues to be raised will be used exclusively for general operating purposes.
