Rules and Regulations of Season Pass Holders

This Pass is good for (1) year starting January 1, 2023 and expiring December 31, 2023

1. The cost of a Season Pass is **\$45.00** and may be purchased at any time during the year, but will expire on December 31, 2023, regardless of when it was purchased.
2. If a vehicle is sold, or a new vehicle needs to be added, you must contact the Parks' Office to make any changes.
3. The Pass must be adhered to the inside of the front windshield on the driver's side of the vehicle and be visible at all times or a citation may occur under Baker County Ordinances.
4. Only 1 (one) vehicle listed on this form may be present in the Park. If you wish to have more than 1 (one) vehicle in the park at the same time, you may purchase a second Season Pass or pay the Day Use fee of \$5.00/day.
5. At no time is the Pass transferable to another vehicle or a non-family member. If a violation of this is found, both the original Pass holder and the recipient will have their Passes revoked for the year.
6. This Pass is good for Day Use Parking and/or Boat Launching *ONLY* and does not pertain to overnight camping.
7. Baker County reserves the right to revoke, or deny purchase of, the Pass at any time for violations of Park rules, regulations and/or Ordinances.
8. Lost or misplaced Passes will not be replaced.
