

## Baker County Give A Way Program 2023/2024

For many years Baker County Weed District has held a herbicide Give-A-Way program. This program may be better called a 'Custom Blend Request Program'.

What you need for this program to benefit you:

1. Bring your approved 5 to 10 gallon container. This may be your sprayer, or other container that is NOT glass nor a container that held an edible food or drink.
2. You need to know what County or State Noxious Weed you are trying to control. A list of these regulatory weeds can be found on our website (Bill, please add a clickable link to Baker County Adopted Noxious Weeds 2023.2024).
  - a. If you don't know what weed it is, bring it along with you for proper identification. This can be a live plant (try to bring roots, stems, leaves, and flowers if possible). Or you can take a picture of it and we will try to identify the plant).
3. Fill out the appropriate form provided by the County when you show up that states you are requesting this custom blend (Give A Way product). We will custom blend you a mix according to where the noxious weed(s) is located (lawn, empty lot, pasture or range, etc). We may combine numerous products to meet your needs.

We host this Give-A-Way program on the following schedule at the listed location – this occurs from April – October every month:

Baker City – the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the month at the Baker County Weed District Office - 1120 So Bridge, Baker City 2:00 – 4:00pm

Richland and Halfway – the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month - Richland at the County Triangle on New Bridge/Highway 86 Intersection. 8:00 – 10:00am - Halfway at the County Yard. 2:00 – 4:00pm

Sumpter – the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of the Month – At Volunteer Park. 2:00 – 4:00pm

Huntington and Hereford – 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of the month – Huntington at Lions Park 8:00 – 10:00am -- Hereford – At Ralph and Cori Morin's house. 2:00 – 4:00pm
